“Sustainable and Energy Efficient Manufacturing”

This session covers developments in energy efficient manufacturing relevant to the automotive and other industries in the supply chain. It focuses on energy efficient technologies and methods used to reduce energy consumption in systems for manufacturing facilities as related to compressed air, motors, process heating, steam, fans, pumps, HVAC, chillers and cooling towers, and lighting systems. You are invited to submit papers for publication and presentation in this session. Selected papers will be recommended for publication as peer reviewed papers in the SAE journals. The following information is required for submission:

1. An abstract up to 500 words that states the objective of the paper/presentation; outlines the problem requiring solution, or the method of approach to research; is explicit with respect to the types of data to be included; and summarizes the conclusions.
2. Tentative title, name of the author and co-authors and all contact information.

Deadline for submitting paper offers (Abstract)	August 16, 2010*
Review Ready Manuscripts due to session organizers	September 30, 2010
Final Manuscripts due to SAE	January 18, 2011
